

## .22 Rifle Silhouette Rules

The .22 caliber rifle silhouette league matches will be held Friday evenings starting at 6:00pm.

The matches will be shot outdoors May through September, and indoors October through April.

The rifle can be any safe .22 rimfire rifle with iron or telescopic sights.

40 shots are fired for record, 20 shots offhand at the chickens and pigs, and 20 shots prone off of cross sticks or a bi-pod at the turkeys and rams. Unlimited sighting shots may be taken. Swinging steel targets are used outdoors and spotters are allowed and recommended. Paper targets are shot indoors and no spotters.

The current entry fee is \$1.50 and is used to pay for targets and prize money. Prize money is paid to the top 50% of the shooters. The amount of the entry fee is reviewed each year at the October business meeting.

Total possible score 40, but if you shoot the entire match offhand you get 2 extra points, and if you use iron sites instead of a scope you get 1 extra point. Ties are broken indoors by the "X" count (The hole is totally in the black).

Each year in October after the annual banquet there will be a business meeting to discuss and vote on any proposed rule changes.

The shoot is open to the public.
