

## BCSC Monthly Black Powder Rifle Rules

5/25/08

1. **NMLRA** rifle rules shall apply except where noted.
2. Fees will be set at the annual October shoot and meeting for the following year.

The current fee is \$1.00 per target plus \$1.00 for the aggregate match.

The end-of-season award is based on the two target aggregate match which consists of the combined scores of the 8-ring 6-bull target shot at 25 yards and the 50-yard single bull target shot at 50 yards. Five shots are fired at each target.

3. Targets will vary. Typical targets are 25 and 50 yard 6-bull, single bull, 2-bull buffalo, and various animal and novelty targets.
4. Course of fire is typically 9 targets with 3 to 5 shots per target for record. There are typically 4 to 5 targets fired at 25 yards and 4 to 5 targets fired at 50 yards. Some matches include one target fired at 100 yards.
5. Time limits per target (5-6 shots) or group of two to three targets (Approximately 9 shots) is 20 to 30 minutes.
6. Any safe muzzle loading rifle may be used of any caliber and type (flint, caplock, traditional or in-line), with any sights.

The Chief Range Officer or Match Director has the right to disallow any rifle determined to be unsafe.

7. Only single, single-set, or double-set triggers may be used. NO release type triggers.
8. Matches are held on the first Sunday of each month. Starting time is 10:00 AM and the match usually ends between 12:30 and 1:00 PM. Lunch is provided after the match.

The first match of the season is the October match and the last match is the September match.

The end-season banquet and season awards are held after the October match each year.

9. No makeup matches are allowed.
10. Monthly cash awards are paid for each target based on the number of shooters.

Season cash awards are paid based on the shooters combined total of the shooters highest nine aggregate matches.
